The replacement of windows in our buildings with energy efficient windows which retain architectural integrity will seal our building "envelope." We will revitalize and restore the main church organ to better support our worship experience. We will install a new HVAC system which will include a geothermal component. Many areas of our facility, including the parish hall and the education building which houses our very successful Day School, will be air conditioned for the first time. When these objectives are accomplished our church will be prepared for future generations. The previous generation had the foresight to build the magnificent church that we worship in every Sunday. Now, it is our turn to prepare for the future. The early stages of this campaign have raised \$2.1 million. To achieve all of these objectives we must raise an additional \$1.5 million toward our \$3.6 million goal. 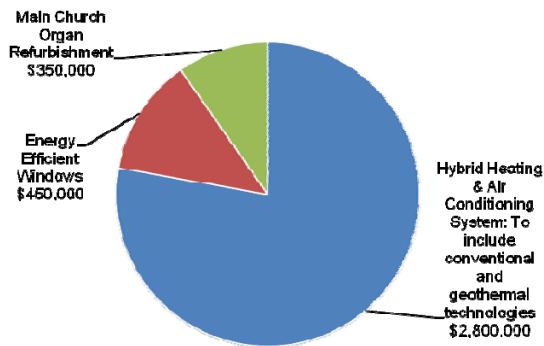
# Capital Campaign Overview

### Deferred Gifts

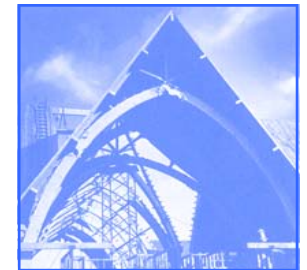
The Church of the Redeemer encourages deferred gifts in its favor through any of a variety of vehicles:
